










Maritime throughput history















Container terminal throughput



Leading container terminal in North Adriatic




Top 6 foreign container markets




Hinterland container markets



New dedicated RO-RO berth – to be completed in 2Q 2020



New railway access 4x 700 m track + loading ramps. To be operational in 1Q 2020



Ongoing investments on Car & Ro-Ro terminal

New garage building

- abt. 6.000 additional parking lots
- works have started in October 2019
- expected implementation in Q4 2020



Major ongoing/planned investments in 2020



New Sermin truck gate



- completed in May 2019,
- 40% of all trucks are diverted there,
- a new truck terminal to be built outside the gate

Entry procedure improvements:

- Vehicle Booking System (VBS) active from May 2019
- Holders of annual pre-paid entry permits enter with a simplified entry procedure,
- Easier arrival planning, better internal port logistic, less traffic in the city.

Key highlights of the strategic business plan 2020 - 2025



Exploiting synergies in the logistics chain, acquiring new strategic markets, renewing long-term and targeted commercial policies, and providing a revenue structure targeted at higher value-added groups.



577 million EUR of investments into increasing the capacity and throughput of the port -> ready for the new railway line Koper – Divača.



Digital transformation in all key processes.


